AN ACT

1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, imposing sentencing
3 without parole.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 9721 of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8 § 9721. Sentencing generally.

9 * * *

10 (f) No parole.--Any person convicted of any act, or attempt
11 to commit the act, of murder, rape, robbery or assault with a
12 deadly weapon, the commission of which directly and proximately
13 resulted in serious physical injury to another and the
14 commission of which follows within five years a previous
15 conviction of another felony, or attempt thereof, resulting in
16 serious physical injury of another, shall, upon conviction,
17 serve such sentence as may be imposed without benefit of parole,

1 notwithstanding any law to the contrary.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
