A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing Congress to extend the expiration date of the
2 mortgage revenue bond program.

3 WHEREAS, The Federal mortgage revenue bond program is
4 scheduled to expire on December 31, 1983; and

5 WHEREAS, ~~Senate Bill 137 has~~ A NUMBER OF BILLS, INCLUDING <—
6 HOUSE RESOLUTION NO.1176, HAVE been introduced to allow mortgage
7 revenue bonds to be issued beyond the scheduled sunset date; and

8 WHEREAS, The mortgage revenue bonds have proven their value
9 to the depressed housing industry and the home-buying public;
10 and

11 WHEREAS, The bonds have created jobs and provided shelter to
12 those Americans most in need of help, the low and moderate
13 income family; and

14 WHEREAS, During a time when direct Federal aid to new housing
15 construction is being substantially diminished in an effort to

1 reduce the Federal deficit; therefore be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the
3 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of the
4 United States to extend the expiration date of the mortgage
5 revenue bond programs; and be it further

6 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
7 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each
8 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
