A RESOLUTION

1 Authorizing a special bipartisan committee to study the future
2 of unused land and buildings at Philadelphia State Hospital
3 at Byberry.

4 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives
5 appoint a special bipartisan committee of seven members, four
6 from the majority party and three from the minority party, to
7 study the future of unused land and buildings at Philadelphia
8 State Hospital at Byberry, with the emphasis on land use
9 planning, not on closing of the facility; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the committee receive input from the Somerton
11 Care Association and from at least one representative of the
12 families of the patients; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings and take
14 testimony at such places as it deems necessary within the
15 Commonwealth; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings and
17 recommendations to the members of the House of Representatives
18 within 180 days.
