A RESOLUTION

- 1 Authorizing a special bipartisan committee to study the future
- of unused land and buildings at Philadelphia State Hospital
- 3 at Byberry.
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives
- 5 appoint a special bipartisan committee of seven members, four
- 6 from the majority party and three from the minority party, to
- 7 study the future of unused land and buildings at Philadelphia
- 8 State Hospital at Byberry, with the emphasis on land use
- 9 planning, not on closing of the facility; and be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the committee receive input from the Somerton
- 11 Care Association and from at least one representative of the
- 12 families of the patients; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings and take
- 14 testimony at such places as it deems necessary within the
- 15 Commonwealth; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings and
- 17 recommendations to the members of the House of Representatives
- 18 within 180 days.
