AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further regulating surrender of license and terms
- 3 of suspension.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1540 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 8 § 1540. Surrender of license.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (c) Violations of driving under influence of alcohol or
- 11 controlled substance. -- Upon a conviction for violating any of
- 12 the provisions of section 3731 (relating to driving under
- 13 influence of alcohol or controlled substance), the defendant
- 14 shall, at the time of sentencing, be notified by the court of
- 15 the suspension or revocation of his operating privilege and
- 16 shall surrender to the court any driver's license which he

- 1 holds. The court shall forward the driver's license together
- 2 with a record of the conviction to the department.
- 3 Section 2. Section 1543(b) of Title 75 is amended to read:
- 4 § 1543. Driving while operating privilege is suspended or
- 5 revoked.
- 6 * * *
- 7 (b) Certain offenses.--Any person who drives a motor vehicle
- 8 on any highway or trafficway of this Commonwealth at a time when
- 9 their operating privilege is suspended or revoked as a condition
- 10 of acceptance of Accelerated Rehabilitative Disposition for a
- 11 violation of section 3731 (relating to driving under influence
- 12 of alcohol or controlled substance) or because of a violation of
- 13 section 1547(b)(1) (relating to suspension for refusal) or 3731
- 14 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a summary offense and shall
- 15 be sentenced to pay a fine of \$1,000 and to undergo imprisonment
- 16 for a period of not less than 90 days. For the purposes of this
- 17 subsection, a suspension or revocation for a violation of
- 18 section 3731 or 1547(b)(1) shall be deemed to begin upon notice
- 19 by the court pursuant to section 1540(c) (relating to surrender
- 20 of license) or 3731(e)(6) but shall not be deemed to end earlier
- 21 than the suspension or revocation actually ends in accordance
- 22 with the other provisions of this title.

- 24 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
