AN ACT

1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for residential electric  
3 rate application to senior citizen centers.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1511. Metering of electricity supplied to senior citizen  
9 centers.

10 A public utility supplying electricity to senior citizen  
11 centers shall measure the consumption of electricity supplied by  
12 the same method that electricity to residential customers is  
13 measured.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
