## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, authorizing ambulance corps member, rescue squad member and paramedic registration plates; and further providing for fees for certain personal registration plates. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 1346. Volunteer ambulance corps, rescue squad and paramedic plate.

On the application of an active volunteer ambulance corps member, rescue squad member or paramedic whose active status for at least 30 days is certified to by the chief of the volunteer ambulance corps or rescue squad or the paramedic, the department shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle as belonging to an active volunteer ambulance corps member, rescue squad member or paramedic. The registration plate shall have a white background, shall have red numbers or letters as
the department may determine and shall have the words "ambulance corps member, rescue squad member or paramedic," as the case may be, in at least ten-point bold type inscribed in red at the bottom. The special registration plate may be used only on one passenger vehicle or one other vehicle with a registered gross weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.

Section 2. Section 1931 of Title 75 is amended to read: § 1931. Personal registration plates.
[The] (a) General rule.--Except as provided in subsection (b), the fee for issuance of a personal registration plate shall be $\$ 20$ which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee. Only one payment of the issuance fee shall be charged for each personal registration issued or replaced.
(b) Fees for volunteers.--The fee for issuance of a personal registration plate for a vehicle belonging to an active member of a volunteer ambulance corps, a rescue squad, a volunteer fireman or a paramedic shall be $\$ 10$.

Section 3. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
