1 2 3 4	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, requiring the financial responsibility identification card to be in the possession of the operator; and further providing for proof of financial responsibility.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Sections 1781 and 1784 of Title 75 of the
8	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
9	§ 1781. Notice of sanction for not evidencing financial
10	responsibility.
11	An applicant for registration of a vehicle shall acknowledge
12	on a form developed by the Department of Transportation that the
13	applicant knows he may lose his operating privilege or vehicle
14	registrations if he fails to evidence financial responsibility
15	for the purposes described in section 1772 (relating to
16	suspension for nonpayment of judgments), 1783 (relating to proof
17	of financial responsibility before restoring operating privilege
18	or registration), 1784 (relating to proof of financial

1 responsibility following violation) [or], 1785 (relating to 2 proof of financial responsibility following accident) or 1788 3 (relating to proof of financial responsibility to be exhibited 4 on demand).

5 § 1784. Proof of financial responsibility following violation. A defendant who is convicted of a traffic offense, other than 6 7 a parking offense, [that requires a court appearance] and who 8 appears in court shall be required to show proof of financial responsibility covering the operation of the vehicle at the time 9 10 of the offense. If the defendant fails to show proof of 11 financial responsibility, the court shall notify the department of that fact. Upon receipt of the notice, the department shall 12 13 revoke the registration of the vehicle. If the defendant is the 14 owner of the vehicle, the department shall also suspend the 15 operating privilege of the defendant. This section does not 16 apply to a defendant who, at the time the offense was committed, exhibited or produced proof of financial responsibility in 17 18 accordance with section 1788 (relating to proof of financial responsibility to be exhibited on demand). 19 20 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding a section to read: § 1788. Proof of financial responsibility to be exhibited on 21 22 demand. 23 Proof of financial responsibility as prescribed by regulations of the department shall be in the possession of the 24 person driving or in control of the vehicle or shall be carried 25 in the vehicle at all times while the vehicle is being driven 26 27 upon a highway, and shall be exhibited upon demand of any police 28 officer. If a person fails to exhibit proof of financial responsibility, he shall have ten days to produce, at the office 29 of the police officer, proof of financial responsibility valid 30

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- in this Commonwealth at the time the demand was made. If the 1
- 2 person fails to produce proof of financial responsibility, the
- 3 office of the police officer shall notify the department of that
- 4 fact. Upon receipt of the notice, the department shall revoke
- the registration of the vehicle. 5
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
