- Amending the act of June 29, 1984 (P.L. , No.7A), entitled "An act to provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the 4 Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal year July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 6 7 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1984; to provide 8 appropriations from the Lottery Fund to the Executive Department; and to provide for the appropriation of Federal 9 funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments of the 10 Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipts 11 12 accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 1984 to June 30, 1985 13 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1984," 14 15 increasing an appropriation to the Department of 16 Transportation. 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
