AN ACT

1 Making an appropriation to the Pennsylvania College of Podiatric  
2 Medicine, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The sum of ~~\$850,000~~ \$837,000 is hereby <—  
6 appropriated to the Pennsylvania College of Podiatric Medicine,  
7 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to  
8 June 30, 1986, for instruction in the Doctor of Podiatric  
9 Medicine program and for participation by a representative of  
10 the institution, appointed by the chief executive officer  
11 thereof, as a member of the Pennsylvania Academic Commission on  
12 Technological Development, a commission for interinstitutional  
13 communication regarding technological innovation and development  
14 and for dissemination of information on such matters to the  
15 Pennsylvania business community and others who may use such  
16 information for new business and job development in

1 Pennsylvania, such commission to be composed of representatives  
2 of every State-owned or State-related educational or scientific  
3 institution receiving General Fund assistance from the  
4 Commonwealth.

5 Section 2. Payments to the Pennsylvania College of Podiatric  
6 Medicine on account of the appropriation provided in section 1  
7 shall be made quarterly by the Secretary of Education on the  
8 basis of costs during the fiscal year.

9 Section 3. The Pennsylvania College of Podiatric Medicine  
10 shall provide such information and in such form and manner as  
11 the Department of Education may prescribe.

12 Section 4. The Pennsylvania College of Podiatric Medicine  
13 shall report its revenues and expenditures and present its  
14 financial statements in accordance with generally accepted  
15 accounting principles and procedures for educational  
16 institutions as set forth in the "Higher Education Finance  
17 Manual of 1975," without exception.

18 Section 5. This act shall take effect July 1, 1985, or, if  
19 enacted subsequent to that date, then immediately.
