AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, further providing for veteran plates and
- 3 registration fees.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Sections 1342(a) and 1901(b) of Title 75 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 1342. Veteran plates and placard.
- 9 (a) Disabled veteran plate. -- On the application of a totally
- 10 disabled veteran, whose disability is certified by the service
- 11 unit of the armed forces in which the veteran served or by the
- 12 United States Veterans' Administration as service-connected, the
- 13 department shall issue a special registration plate designating
- 14 the vehicle as belonging to a totally disabled veteran. The
- 15 registration plate shall have a white background, shall have
- 16 blue numbers or letters as the department may determine, and
- 17 shall have the words, "disabled veteran," in at least ten-point
- 18 bold type, inscribed in red at the bottom of the plate. The

- 1 special registration plate may be used only on one passenger
- 2 vehicle or one other vehicle with a registered gross weight of
- 3 not more than 9,000 pounds.

- 5 § 1901. Exemption of entities and vehicles from fees.
- 6 * * *
- 7 (b) Title and registration fees.--No fee shall be charged
- 8 for titling or registration of any of the following:
- 9 (1) Buses registered by urban mass transportation
- 10 systems.
- 11 (2) Vehicles registered by volunteer fire, rescue and
- 12 ambulance associations.
- 13 (3) Vehicles registered by foreign nationals with the
- 14 rank of vice consul or higher assigned to a consulate in this
- 15 Commonwealth provided that citizens of the United States are
- 16 granted reciprocal exemptions.
- 17 (4) Vehicles of totally disabled veterans whose
- disability is certified by the service unit of the armed
- 19 forces in which the veterans served or by the United States
- 20 Veterans' Administration as service-connected.

- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
