AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104, No.3), entitled, as
2 reenacted and amended, "An act providing property tax or rent
3 rebate and inflation dividends to certain senior citizens,
4 widows, widowers and permanently disabled persons with
5 limited incomes; establishing uniform standards and
6 qualifications for eligibility to receive rebates and
7 dividends; providing for transportation assistance grants and
8 grants to area agencies on aging for services to older
9 persons; and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue,"
10 prescribing a minimum size type on forms.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 9 of the act of March 11, 1971 (P.L.104,
14 No.3), known as the Senior Citizens Rebate and Assistance Act,
15 reenacted and amended June 16, 1975 (P.L.7, No.4), amended
16 December 21, 1979 (P.L.570, No.131), is amended to read:

17 Section 9. Claim Forms and Rules and Regulations.--Necessary
18 rules and regulations shall be prescribed by a committee
19 consisting of the Secretaries of Aging, Revenue and Community
20 Affairs. The Secretary of Aging shall serve as the chairman of
21 the committee. The Department of Revenue shall receive all

1 applications, determine the eligibility of claimants, hear
2 appeals, disburse payments, and make available suitable forms
3 for the filing of claims. All forms utilized by the department
4 in the administration of this act which are required to be
5 executed by or are sent to claimants shall be printed in at
6 least 14-point type.

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
