- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated

- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. Section 1519(a) of the Title 75 of the 6
- Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7
- 8 § 1519. Determination of incompetency.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- The department, having cause to believe
- 10 that a licensed driver or applicant may not be physically or
- 11 mentally qualified to be licensed, may obtain the advice of a
- physician who shall cause an examination to be made or who shall 12
- 13 designate any other qualified physician. The licensed driver or
- applicant may cause a written report to be forwarded to the 14
- 15 department by a physician of the driver's or applicant's choice.
- 16 Vision qualifications shall be determined by an optometrist or
- 17 ophthalmologist. Correction through the use of telescopic lenses
- shall be acceptable for the purposes of meeting visual acuity 18

- 1 <u>requirements.</u> The department shall appoint one or more qualified
- 2 persons who shall consider all medical reports and testimony and
- 3 determine the competency of the driver or the applicant to
- 4 drive.

- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
