AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 30, 1985 (No.5A), entitled "An act to 2 provide from the General Fund for the expenses of the 3 Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the 4 Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for 5 the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close 7 of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985; to provide appropriations from the Lottery Fund to the Executive 8 9 Department; and to provide for the appropriation of Federal 10 funds to the Executive and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth and for the establishment of restricted receipts 11 accounts for the fiscal year July 1, 1985, to June 30, 1986, 12 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at 13 14 the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 1985, and 15 providing additional appropriations to the Executive and 16 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal year 17 July 1, 1984, to June 30, 1985, "further clarifying 18 appropriation purposes. 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
