AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 2 Statutes, providing for the acceptance of identification
- 3 cards as a form of identification.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 1510(b) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended and the section is amended by
- 8 adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license.
- 10 * * *
- 11 (b) Identification card. -- The department shall, upon payment
- 12 of the required fee, issue an identification card to any person
- 13 who has made application therefor in such manner as the
- 14 department shall prescribe. The identification card shall have
- 15 substantially the same content as a driver's license but shall
- 16 clearly indicate that it is not a driver's license. <u>In addition</u>,
- 17 the department shall include with each identification card a

- 1 notice of the provisions contained in subsection (e). Upon
- 2 failure of any person to pass any examination required under
- 3 section 1514 (relating to expiration and renewal of drivers'
- 4 licenses), the department shall, where appropriate, issue a
- 5 complimentary identification card as an expression of gratitude
- 6 for years of safe driving. The card shall only be issued upon
- 7 receipt of the person's driver's license.
- 8 * * *
- 9 (e) Use of identification cards.--If a person has an
- 10 <u>established policy of accepting a driver's license issued</u>
- 11 pursuant to subsection (a) for the purpose of identification for
- 12 the acceptance of a check given for payment of purchase or for
- 13 the cashing of a check, the person shall also accept an
- 14 identification card issued pursuant to subsection (b) for the
- 15 <u>same purpose</u>. It shall be a defense to a prosecution under this
- 16 <u>subsection that the person was not presented with the notice of</u>
- 17 the provisions of this subsection included with the
- 18 identification card issued by the department.
- 19 Section 2. Within ten days after the effective date of this
- 20 act, the department shall send by mail to each person who holds
- 21 a currently valid identification card as of the effective date
- 22 of the act, the notice required by 75 Pa.C.S. § 1510(b)
- 23 (relating to identification card) to be included with the
- 24 identification card.
- 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
