AN ACT

Amending the act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, No.428), entitled 2 "An act relating to roads, streets, highways and bridges; 3 amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws administered by the Secretary of Highways and by the 4 5 Department of Highways relating thereto, "providing for 6 certain relocation costs. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of June 1, 1945 (P.L.1242, No.428), known 9 10 as the State Highway Law, is amended by adding a section to 11 read: 12 Section 1008. Relocation Costs for Public Utility Facilities Where Federal Funds Available. -- (a) The cost of relocation of 13 14 the facilities of public utilities necessitated by the 15 construction, reconstruction, widening or relocation of any State highway, bridge or tunnel, or any part thereof, which is 16 17 part of a project for which some portion of the cost is to be reimbursed to the department from Federal funds, shall be 18 reimbursed to the owner of the public utility facilities by the 19

- 2 (b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply to the
- 3 reimbursement for costs incurred in the construction,
- 4 relocation, alteration, protection or abolition of railroad-
- 5 highway crossings which are subject to 66 Pa.C.S. Ch.27
- 6 (relating to railroads).
- 7 (c) For purposes of this subsection, the following terms
- 8 shall have the following meanings:
- 9 (1) The term "cost of relocation" shall include the entire
- 10 amount paid by the owner of the public utility for relocation of
- 11 the public utility facilities after deducting from that amount
- 12 any increase in the value of the new facilities and any salvage
- 13 <u>value derived from the old facilities.</u>
- 14 (2) The term "facilities" shall include all "facilities" of
- 15 <u>all "public utilities" as those terms are defined in 66 Pa.C.S.</u>
- 16 § 102 (relating to definitions).
- 17 (3) The term "public utility" shall include: (i) any person
- 18 or corporation which is a "public utility" as defined in 66
- 19 Pa.C.S. § 102; and (ii) any person or corporation providing like
- 20 <u>services which is regulated by an agency of the Federal</u>
- 21 government.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
