AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled 2 "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration 3 thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of 4 5 funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," 6 7 providing that delinquent State and local taxes shall be 8 deducted from lottery prizes.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),

12 known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section

13 to read:

14 <u>Section 8.1. Offset for Delinquent Taxes.--Prior to the</u>

15 payment of any prize of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more

16 from the State Lottery Fund, the secretary shall cause a search

17 to be made of the records of the Department of Revenue for

18 <u>delinquent State taxes owed by the prizewinner. The secretary</u>

1	shall also require the prizewinner, as a prerequisite to the
2	receipt of any such prize, to produce a verified statement or
3	statements from the local tax collector or collectors of the
4	political subdivision in which the prizewinner resides, that the
5	prizewinner is not delinquent in the payment of any local taxes
6	or, if he is delinquent, the amount of the delinquency. If a
7	prizewinner is found to be delinquent in the payment of any
8	State or local taxes, the secretary shall offset the amount of
9	delinguencies against the amount of the prize. The secretary
10	shall deduct from the prize, and draw his warrants for the
11	amounts offset in favor of the department as to delinquent State
12	taxes, and in favor of the political subdivisions as to
13	delinguent local taxes, for payment of the delinguencies, and
14	for any balance, in favor of the prizewinner. In any case in
15	which the amount of State or local tax due is in dispute, the
16	department shall withhold payment of the amount claimed to be
17	due by the taxing authorities until such time as the dispute is
18	finally resolved. The secretary may provide by regulation for
19	the form and content of statements required from local tax
20	<u>collectors.</u>

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
