1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Amending the act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), entitled "An act providing for a State Lottery and administration thereof; authorizing the creation of a State Lottery Commission; prescribing its powers and duties; disposition of funds; violations and penalties therefor; exemption of prizes from State and local taxation and making an appropriation," providing that certain persons who win lottery prizes shall be required to make payment to the Department of Public Welfare.
10	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
11	hereby enacts as follows:
12	Section 1. The act of August 26, 1971 (P.L.351, No.91),
13	known as the State Lottery Law, is amended by adding a section
14	to read:
15	Section 8.1. Cash Assistance Recipients(a) Any person
16	who wins a lottery prize of five hundred dollars (\$500) or more
17	and received cash assistance within the previous seven years
18	shall be required to reimburse the Department of Public Welfare
19	for the Commonwealth share of the cash assistance, up to the
20	amount of the lottery prize won.
21	(b) Prior to the payment of any prize of five hundred

1	dollars (\$500) or more from the State Lottery Fund, the
2	secretary shall cause a search to be made of the records of the
3	Bureau of Cash Assistance of the Department of Public Welfare.
4	If a prize winner is currently delinquent in payments to the
5	Department of Public Welfare, the secretary shall offset the
6	amount of the delinguency against the amount of the prize. The
7	secretary shall deduct from the prize, and draw his warrants for
8	the amount offset in favor of the Department of Public Welfare
9	for payment of the delinquency and, for any balance, in favor of
10	the prizewinner.
11	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
