## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing penalties for theft of
- 3 certain flags.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 2104. Theft of Federal or Commonwealth flag.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- A person who unlawfully takes an American
- 10 flag or the flag of the Commonwealth which is on display commits
- 11 a misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon conviction, be
- 12 <u>sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$2,500 or to</u>
- 13 imprisonment for not more than one year, or both.
- 14 (b) Burial flags. -- A person who unlawfully takes an American
- 15 flag which has been presented as a burial flag by the government
- 16 of the United States to the survivors of an American veteran
- 17 commits a misdemeanor of the second degree and shall, upon
- 18 conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$5,000

- 1 or to imprisonment for not more than two years, or both.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
