A RESOLUTION

- 1 Providing for a bipartisan special committee to investigate the
- 2 Mid-Atlantic States Association in relation to academic
- 3 evaluations of member institutions of the State System of
- 4 Higher Education.
- 5 WHEREAS, Questions have arisen relating to the
- 6 appropriateness and validity of the academic evaluation process
- 7 used by the Mid-Atlantic States Association in evaluating member
- 8 institutions of the State System of Higher Education; therefore
- 9 be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Speaker of the House of Representatives
- 11 appoint a special committee of five members of the House, three
- 12 from the majority party and two from the minority party, to
- 13 investigate the academic evaluation process of the Mid-Atlantic
- 14 States Association; and be it further
- 15 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 16 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 17 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
- 18 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to

- witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
- 2 RESOLVED, That the committee report its findings and
- 3 recommendations to the House of Representatives as soon as
- 4 possible.
