A RESOLUTION

- 3 WHEREAS, Recently all levels of government have cut back on
- 4 the funding of many programs that affect persons from all walks
- 5 of life, including, but not limited to, the poor, the low and
- 6 moderate income adults, the elderly and our youth; and
- WHEREAS, What effect these cuts have has to be fully
- 8 explored; therefore be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the Urban Affairs Committee investigate and
- 10 hold public hearings on the impact of the Federal, State and
- 11 local cuts on the poor, the low and moderate income adults, the
- 12 elderly and our youth; and be it further
- 13 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 14 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 15 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee
- 16 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 17 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of its findings
- 2 and recommendations as soon as possible to the General Assembly.
