### A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the week of October 6 through October 13, 1985, as  
2 "Pennsylvania Housing Week."

3 WHEREAS, Shelter is one of the basic needs for all  
4 individuals and the production of affordable housing is an  
5 important concern at all levels of government; and

6 WHEREAS, The opportunity to own a home and live in decent  
7 housing strengthens the family, the community and the State,  
8 giving individual Pennsylvanians a stake in the local community;  
9 and

10 WHEREAS, The homebuilding industry plays a key role in the  
11 economic and civic progress of the Commonwealth; and

12 WHEREAS, Construction of new housing provides jobs for  
13 Pennsylvanians, stimulates the use of materials manufactured in  
14 the Keystone State and encourages the expansion and further  
15 development of related industries; and

16 WHEREAS, It is appropriate to reaffirm Pennsylvania's  
17 historical commitment to housing and home ownership and to

1 recognize the economic opportunities created by housing;

2 therefore be it

3       RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the  
4 week of October 6 through October 13, 1985, as "Pennsylvania  
5 Housing Week."
