A RESOLUTION

1 Directing the State Government Committee to investigate the
2 adequacy of laws relating to disclosure of the use of public
3 funds by nonprofit corporations.

4 WHEREAS, A substantial number of Commonwealth nonprofit
5 corporations have annual budgets which exceed the financial
6 outlays of certain municipalities in this Commonwealth; and

7 WHEREAS, In certain cases, a substantial amount of the income
8 of nonprofit corporations is derived from tax dollars; and

9 WHEREAS, In certain cases, nonprofit corporations are able to
10 conduct their affairs without full public disclosure of the
11 spending of government funds; and

12 WHEREAS, The public has a right to know how its tax dollars
13 are being spent; therefore be it

14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the State
15 Government Committee to conduct hearings into the operations of
16 nonprofit corporations to determine if there is a need for
17 legislation to require more comprehensive disclosure of the use
18 of public funds by nonprofit corporations and present a report

1 and recommendations to the House of Representatives within six
2 months.
