A RESOLUTION

Urging public television affiliates in Pennsylvania to air the 1 2 Canadian documentary, "Harvest of Despair." 3 WHEREAS, The award-winning Canadian documentary, "Harvest of Despair," dealing with the Soviet-managed famine which took 4 place in the Ukraine during the 1930's, is not being carried by 5 any public television affiliates in Pennsylvania; and 6 7 WHEREAS, "Harvest of Despair" depicts the trials of an 8 estimated three million Ukrainians who starved to death, while just a few miles across the border in the Russian-Soviet 9 10 Federated Socialist Republic there were large surpluses of food which were not permitted into the Ukraine by the Soviets; and 11 12 WHEREAS, This documentary has been routinely rejected for 13 airing by public television stations because of what is termed 14 its "anti-Soviet" bias; and WHEREAS, There exists great interest in this program by 15

16 Pennsylvania citizens of Slavic ancestry, as well as other

concerned citizens of this Commonwealth; therefore be it
RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives urge and
encourage public television affiliates in Pennsylvania to air
the award-winning Canadian documentary, "Harvest of Despair," in
the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
