A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing September 26, 1986, as "Singles Recognition Day,"
2 commending the agencies which promote and serve the interests
3 and goals of single individuals and encouraging participation
4 in the Pittsburgh Singles Recognition Day Celebration and
5 Exposition being held this day at the Marriott Hotel in
6 Monroeville.

7 WHEREAS, There are significant social, cultural, civic and
8 economic contributions made by single individuals to the growth
9 and stability of this Commonwealth; and

10 WHEREAS, One-third of the population of this Commonwealth is
11 currently single. This proportion is expected to increase
12 significantly by the year 1990; therefore be it

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize
14 September 26, 1986, as "Singles Recognition Day," commending the
15 agencies which promote and serve the interests and goals of
16 single individuals and encouraging participation in the
17 Pittsburgh Singles Recognition Day Celebration and Exposition
