## AN ACT

Imposing duties on persons who sell dogs in the regular course 1 of business; providing a summary offense for 2 misrepresentation of pedigree and health of dogs bred for 3 4 sale; and providing for the enforcement of this act by the Attorney General. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Certification of purchased dog's health. 8 9 (a) General rule. -- A kennel, pet shop operator or other individual who sells dogs to the public in the regular course of 10 11 business shall provide a purchaser of a dog with a health certificate for the dog at the time of its sale. 12 Contents of health certificate. -- The certificate of 13 (b) 14 health shall set forth the following: 15 (1) The dog's breed. (2) 16 The dog's age. 17 (3) The dog's sex.

- (4) The dog's color.

(5) The dog's date of birth.

3 (6) A list of vaccinations administered to the dog, the
4 date of vaccinations and the name of the person who
5 administered them.

6 (7) The date and type any parasiticidal medicine was7 administered to the dog.

8 AS TO A DOG THAT IS NOT ADVERTISED OR SOLD AS BEING REGISTERED
9 OR REGISTERABLE, PARAGRAPH (2) (RELATING TO THE DOG'S AGE) MAY
10 BE APPROXIMATED, AND PARAGRAPH (5) (RELATING TO THE DOG'S DATE
11 OF BIRTH) SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED.

12 (c) Return of dog for illness.--If within ten days of its 13 purchase a dog purchased from a person in the regular course of 14 the seller's business dies of any illness or condition existing <---15 on the date of sale or manifests a contagious or disabling 16 illness existing, but which was not discernible at the time of 17 purchase, BUSINESS MANIFESTS OR DIES OF ANY CONTAGIOUS AND/OR <-----18 INFECTIOUS ILLNESS OR DIES OF ANY PARASITIC ILLNESS, the purchaser may return it to the seller either for a complete 19 20 refund, including sales tax, or for a replacement animal of 21 equal value, as the purchaser chooses. A veterinarian's 22 certification of illness issued by a licensed veterinarian shall be necessary to return a dog under this subsection and shall be 23 24 supplied at the purchaser's expense. The veterinarian's 25 certificate shall set forth that he examined the dog, that the 26 dog has a contagious or disabling illness OR HAD AN ILLNESS AS <----27 SET FORTH ABOVE which renders it unfit for purchase OR RESULTED <-----28 IN ITS DEATH and the precise findings of the examination OR <-----NECROPSY. 29

30 (d) Return of dog for poor health.--If within 30 days of 19870H0076B3496 - 2 -

purchase a dog purchased from a person in the regular course of 1 the seller's business is determined, through physical 2 <----3 examination OR NECROPSY by a veterinarian, to be in poor health <-----4 OR TO HAVE DIED due to congenital malformation or dysfunction, <-----5 the purchaser may return it to the seller either for a complete refund, including sales tax, or for a replacement animal of 6 7 equal value, as the purchaser chooses. A veterinarian's certification of poor health OR DEATH due to congenital 8 malformation or dysfunction shall be necessary to return a dog 9 <-----10 LIVING DOG OR TO RECEIVE A REFUND OR REPLACEMENT FOR A DOG WHICH <----11 HAS DIED under this subsection. The certification shall be issued by a licensed veterinarian at the purchaser's expense, 12 13 shall set forth the congenital malformation or dysfunction and 14 shall state that, due to the congenital malformation or 15 dysfunction, the dog DIED OR is unfit for the purpose for which <-16 it was purchased.

(e) Limitation on returns.--Subsections (c) and (d) shall not apply where a seller, in certifying the health of a dog in accordance with subsection (a), discloses at the time of sale the health problem for which the buyer later seeks to return the dog and adjusts the purchase price at the time of sale to reflect the dog's health problem.

23 Section 2. Certification of purchased dog's registration.

If a kennel or pet shop operator or other person who sells dogs to the public in the regular course of business advertises that a dog is registered or registrable, he shall provide the purchaser of the dog with the following at the time of sale:

28 (1) The breeder's name and address if the purchaser so
29 requires.

30 (2) The name and registration number of the dam and sire 19870H0076B3496 - 3 - 1 of the purchased dog's litter.

All documentation necessary to transfer the registered ownership of the dog, including the dog registration application and any supplemental ownership transfer papers, as well as other information required by the registrar, shall be provided by the seller to the owner within 120 days of the date of sale.
SECTION 3. POSTING.

8 THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT SHALL BE CONSPICUOUSLY POSTED IN 9 THE PLACE OF BUSINESS OF PERSONS SUBJECT TO THE PROVISIONS OF 10 THIS ACT IN SUCH FORM AND MANNER AS SHALL BE PRESCRIBED BY THE 11 ATTORNEY GENERAL BY REGULATION.

12 Section <del>3</del> 4. Penalties.

A violation of any provision of this act shall be deemed to
be a violation of the act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224,
No.387), known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer
Protection Law.

17 Section 4 5. Enforcement.

18 The Attorney General shall enforce this act and shall 19 promulgate rules and regulations that the Attorney General deems 20 necessary for that enforcement. All fines and penalties which 21 are collected for violations of this act are hereby appropriated 22 to the Attorney General to cover the costs of enforcing the 23 provisions of this act.

24 Section 5 6. Applicability.

This act shall not apply to nonprofit kennels as that term is defined under the act of December 7, 1982 (P.L.784, No.225),

27 known as the Dog Law.

28 Section <del>6</del> 7. Effective date.

29 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
