## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, prohibiting the possession and use of
- 3 certain electrical devices.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6163. Devices releasing charge of electricity.
- 9 (a) Offense defined.--A person commits an offense if he
- 10 possesses, sells, buys, conveys or uses any electrical or
- 11 electronic device designed to release a charge of electricity
- 12 <u>into an animal or person, including, but not limited to, devices</u>
- 13 commonly known as cattle prods and stun guns.
- 14 (b) Grading. -- An offense under this section is a misdemeanor
- 15 of the second degree.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
