AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for the collection of the Catastrophic
3 Loss Trust Fund fee by the department.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1762 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

8 § 1762. Funding.

9 The Catastrophic Loss Trust Fund shall be funded by levying
10 an initial charge of \$5 upon all motor vehicles required to be
11 registered under Chapter 13 (relating to registration of
12 vehicles) except trailers, recreational vehicles not intended
13 for highway use, motorcycles, motor-driven cycles, motorized
14 pedalcycles or like type vehicles. This charge shall be remitted
15 to [an insurance company or other party as may be designated by
16 the Insurance Department] the Department of Transportation, upon

1 the effective date of this act or when the board designates the
2 department as the collection agency, whichever first occurs.
3 Upon receipt of the charge, the [insurance company or other
4 designated party] department shall remit it to the Insurance
5 Department for deposit in the trust fund. The Catastrophic Loss
6 Trust Fund Board shall, by regulation, determine by January 1 of
7 each calendar year the amount of the fund charge for each
8 registration year subsequent to the initial registration year
9 and shall notify the Insurance Department which shall notify the
10 [insurance companies or other designated parties] Department of
11 Transportation to collect the charge.

12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
