AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, providing for the issuance of commemorative front
3 plates in honor of the Bicentennial of the United States
4 Constitution.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8 Statutes is amended by adding sections to read:

9 § 1348. Bicentennial of the United States Constitution
10 commemorative plates.

11 (a) Issuance.--Upon application of any person, the
12 department shall issue a commemorative front plate in honor of
13 the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution. The plate
14 shall have a blue background and bear such gold designs and
15 characters, including the dates 1787-1987, as the department may
16 determine to be appropriate.

1 (b) Display.--A commemorative plate in honor of the
2 Bicentennial of the United States Constitution may be displayed
3 only on the front of a vehicle, and shall not constitute a
4 registration plate.

5 (c) Duty of department.--The department shall publicize the
6 availability of commemorative front plates in honor of the
7 Bicentennial of the United States Constitution and shall include
8 promotional material and applications for such plates with
9 renewal notices for registration plates for the year 1987 and
10 thereafter as it may deem appropriate.

11 § 1961. Bicentennial of the United States Constitution
12 commemorative plates.

13 The fee for issuance of a commemorative front plate in honor
14 of the Bicentennial of the United States Constitution shall be
15 \$10.

16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
