## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
- 2 entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
- and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," increasing
- 4 the penalty for ordinance violations.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 3308 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965
- 8 P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, repealed in part
- 9 April 28, 1978 (P.L.202, No.53), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 3308. Collection of Penalties. -- No fine or penalty
- 11 shall exceed [three hundred dollars (\$300)] one thousand dollars
- 12  $\frac{(\$1,000)}{(\$1,000)}$  for any single violation of any ordinance.] ONE
- 13 THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) FOR A VIOLATION OF A BUILDING,
- 14 HOUSING, PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, HEALTH, FIRE OR PUBLIC SAFETY
- 15 CODE OR ORDINANCE AND FOR WATER, AIR AND NOISE POLLUTION
- 16 VIOLATIONS, AND SHALL NOT EXCEED SIX HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$600) FOR
- 17 A VIOLATION OF ANY OTHER BOROUGH ORDINANCE.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
