AN ACT

1	Amending the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), entitled "An
2 3	act providing for the administration of a statewide system of
3 4	vital statistics; prescribing the functions of the State Department of Health, the State Advisory Health Board and
4 5	local registrars; imposing duties upon coroners,
6	prothonotaries, clerks of orphans' court, physicians,
7	midwives and other persons; requiring reports and
8	certificates for the registration of vital statistics;
9	regulating the disposition of dead bodies; limiting the
10	disclosure of records; prescribing the sufficiency of vital
11	statistics records as evidence; prescribing fees and
12	penalties; and revising and consolidating the laws relating
13	thereto," providing that death certificates shall include
14	certain additional information.
15	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
16	hereby enacts as follows:
17	Section 1. Section 204 of the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304,
18	No.66), known as the Vital Statistics Law of 1953, is amended to
19	read:
20	Section 204. Department: FormsThe department shall
21	prescribe the forms for all certificates required by this act.
22	The department may prescribe all other forms necessary for

collecting, transcribing, compiling and preserving vital
statistics. The department shall include in such forms all
standard items which contribute to a uniform comparable
nationwide system of vital statistics. <u>Death certificate forms</u>
<u>shall include a space for entry of the surname of the deceased</u>
<u>prior to taking any other name by marriage.</u>
Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
