AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for an opportunity for
- 3 municipalities to purchase real property being disposed of by
- 4 public utilities.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 66 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 1512. Disposition of real property.
- 10 (a) Notice.--Before a public utility disposes of real
- 11 property, it must notify the city, borough, incorporated town or
- 12 township in which the real property is located.
- 13 (b) Procedure after notice. -- If the notified municipality
- 14 takes no action within 60 days of receipt of notice, the public
- 15 utility may dispose of the real property. If the notified
- 16 municipality makes an offer to purchase the real property within
- 17 60 days of receipt of notice, the public utility shall consider

- 1 the offer and make a decision on the offer before making other
- 2 <u>disposition of the property.</u>
- (c) Violation. -- If a public utility disposes of real 3
- 4 property without complying with this section, the disposition is
- 5 <u>voidable.</u>
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 6
