## AN ACT

Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing a criminal penalty 2 for activities by unlicensed brokers; and requiring a public 4 information program on brokerage licenses. 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 2505 of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 9 § 2505. Licenses and financial responsibility required of 10 brokers. 11 12 (e) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section commits a 13 misdemeanor of the third degree and shall, upon conviction for a 14 first offense, be sentenced to a fine not to exceed \$1,000 or to 15 imprisonment of not more than six months, or both, and, upon conviction of a second offense, be sentenced to a fine not to 16

exceed \$2,000 or to imprisonment for a term of six months to one
