AN ACT

Amending the act of September 28, 1978 (P.L.788, No.152), entitled "An act amending Titles 1 (General Provisions) and 2 3 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, responding to and prescribing 5 limitations on decisional law, reaffirming sovereign immunity as provided in section 11 of Article I of the Constitution of 7 Pennsylvania, preserving sovereign immunity as a bar to claims brought against Commonwealth agencies and their 8 9 officials and employees; specifically waiving sovereign 10 immunity as provided by the Constitution in certain limited cases; granting jurisdiction to certain courts over claims 11 brought against Commonwealth agencies; providing for 12 13 limitations upon and the procedures relating to said claims; 14 authorizing rules and regulations; suspending certain 15 judicial proceedings until July 1, 1979, shortening the statutes of limitations in certain cases; and repealing 16 certain laws," changing the effective date for certain 17 18 occurrences; and extending a statute of limitations. 19 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 20 hereby enacts as follows: 21 Section 1. The act of September 28, 1978 (P.L.788, No.152), entitled "An act amending Titles 1 (General Provisions) and 42 23 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the Pennsylvania 24 Consolidated Statutes, responding to and prescribing limitations 25 on decisional law, reaffirming sovereign immunity as provided in

- 1 section 11 of Article I of the Constitution of Pennsylvania,
- 2 preserving sovereign immunity as a bar to claims brought against
- 3 Commonwealth agencies and their officials and employees;
- 4 specifically waiving sovereign immunity as provided by the
- 5 Constitution in certain limited cases; granting jurisdiction to
- 6 certain courts over claims brought against Commonwealth
- 7 agencies; providing for limitations upon and the procedures
- 8 relating to said claims; authorizing rules and regulations;
- 9 suspending certain judicial proceedings until July 1, 1979,
- 10 shortening the statutes of limitations in certain cases; and
- 11 repealing certain laws," is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 5.1. Applicability.</u>
- The provisions of this act shall apply to any occurrence,
- 14 accident or incident which took place after January 1, 1968,
- 15 where:
- 16 (1) the aggrieved party suffered serious, permanent and
- 17 disabling injuries as a result of the negligence of the
- 18 Commonwealth;
- 19 (2) a negligence suit was originally timely filed;
- 20 (3) the suit was barred from a proper remedy due to the
- 21 <u>so-called "sovereign immunity" doctrine; and</u>
- 22 (4) the suit was again filed within two years of the
- decision in Mayle v. Pennsylvania Department of Highways, 479
- 24 <u>Pa. 384 (1978).</u>
- 25 Section 2. Section 5(d) of the act is repealed insofar as it
- 26 is inconsistent with this act.
- 27 Section 3. Section 6 of the act is amended to read:
- 28 Section 6. Effective date.
- 29 This act shall take effect immediately <u>and shall apply</u>
- 30 retroactively to January 1, 1968, as provided for in section

- $1 \quad 5.1.$
- 2 Section 4. The time limitations as set forth in 42 Pa.C.S. §
- 3 5522(a) (relating to six months limitations) shall be extended
- 4 by an additional six months only for the purposes of this act.
- 5 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
