## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the
- 3 dismissal of certain criminal charges.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 8933. Dismissal of criminal cases.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- In a felony case, where no attorney
- 10 appears on behalf of the Commonwealth at a preliminary hearing
- 11 or where the victim fails to appear, the issuing authority shall
- 12 not discharge the defendant for this reason until the issuing
- 13 authority makes a reasonable attempt to locate the attorney or
- 14 victim and provides him an opportunity to appear.
- (b) Disposition. -- Failure to comply with this section shall
- 16 <u>not be construed as grounds for retrial.</u>
- 17 (c) Definition.--As used in this section the term

- 1 <u>"reasonable attempt" means requiring court personnel to attempt</u>
- 2 to locate the attorney or victim within the courthouse, office
- 3 or place of residence.
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
