AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.926, No.369), entitled "An act for the protection of the public health by regulating the conduct and operation of public eating and drinking places within this Commonwealth; requiring their licensing; imposing certain duties on the Department of Health of this Commonwealth and on the local health authorities; and providing penalties," banning the use of disposable styrofoam food or beverage containers.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. The act of May 23, 1945 (P.L.926, No.369),
- 12 referred to as the Public Eating and Drinking Place Law, is
- 13 amended by adding a section to read:
- 14 <u>Section 8.1.</u> <u>Disposable Styrofoam Containers.--Disposable</u>
- 15 food or beverage containers shall not be made of styrofoam or
- 16 other nonbiodegradable materials.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in six months.
