AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for notice of department action.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 1551 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

7 § 1551. Notice of department action.

8 The department shall promptly [notify] mail a notice to each
9 person whose license or permit is suspended as a result of the
10 accumulation of points under section 1539 (relating to
11 suspension of operating privilege on accumulation of points).

12 The [notification that the license or permit is suspended shall
13 be made] notice shall be mailed to the address of record within
14 six months [following] OF RECEIPT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NOTICE OF ←
15 the conviction of a violation of this title that resulted in the
16 addition of sufficient points to cause the suspension. Failure

1 of the department to [give prompt] mail a notice of suspension
2 as required by this section shall prohibit the department from
3 suspending the license or permit of such person. This section
4 shall not apply to points assigned to a person's record after
5 assignment of points which form the basis of an appeal under
6 section 1550 (relating to judicial review) until the appeal
7 shall be finally determined, and for six months thereafter, or
8 to a suspension ordered as a result of recalculation of a
9 person's point record as a result of a court order.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
