AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge over the Allegheny River in Allegheny
2 County, as the Joseph F. Bonetto Memorial Bridge.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Name of bridge.

6 The bridge over the Allegheny River, known as the Hulton
7 Bridge, which carries L.R. 02236 between the Borough of Oakmont
8 and the Township of Harmar in Allegheny County, is hereby
9 officially designated and shall be known as the Joseph B.
10 Bonetto Memorial Bridge.

11 Section 2. Signs or markers.

12 The Department of Transportation shall erect appropriate
13 signs or markers to evidence the name of the bridge.

14 Section 3. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect immediately.
