6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 2701 of Title 30 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
9	§ 2701. Resident fishing licenses.

11	(c) Incapacitated personsA person, other than a disabled
12	veteran, as provided for in section 2707 (relating to disabled
13	veterans), who is unable to engage in gainful employment due to
14	medical reasons and who complies with subsection (a)(1) and (2)
15	is entitled to an "Incapacitated Fishing License" if he pays a
16	license fee of \$2 to the issuing agent or the commission plus a
17	service fee of 50ç to the issuing agent. Any person applying for
18	a license under this subsection must present a statement,

- 1 <u>certified by a physician licensed to practice in this</u>
- 2 Commonwealth, that the person is unable to engage in gainful
- 3 <u>employment due to medical reasons.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
