AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, imposing additional penalties when trucks overturn in accidents resulting from certain violations.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 3756. Accidents involving overturned trucks.
9	<u>If a truck, truck tractor or trailer overturns in an accident</u>
10	resulting from a violation of section 3361 (relating to driving
11	vehicle at safe speed), 3362 (relating to maximum speed limits),
12	3714 (relating to reckless driving), 3731 (relating to driving
13	under influence of alcohol or controlled substance), 4103
14	(relating to promulgation of vehicle equipment standards), 4502
15	(relating to general requirements for braking systems) or 4903
16	(relating to securing loads in vehicles), the operator of such
17	vehicle shall, upon conviction of any of the aforementioned
18	offenses, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$1,000 nor

- 1 more than \$5,000, in addition to any other penalty authorized by
- 2 <u>law.</u>
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
