AN ACT

- 1 Providing for radon testing in public buildings; conferring
- 2 powers and duties on the Department of Environmental
- 3 Resources; and making an appropriation.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Short title.
- 7 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Public
- 8 Building Radon Detection Act.
- 9 Section 2. Definitions.
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 11 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Department." The Department of Environmental Resources of
- 14 the Commonwealth.
- 15 "Public building." A building owned or leased by the
- 16 Commonwealth or a political subdivision.

- 1 Section 3. Program.
- 2 (a) Testing. -- The department shall test all public buildings
- 3 for the presence of radon. Testing shall be done on all ground
- 4 floors and below-ground floors. Test results of 4 pCi/1 are
- 5 acceptable. Test results exceeding 4 pCi/1 require retesting.
- 6 Retest results exceeding 4 pCi/1 indicate a health risk. Each
- 7 building shall be tested every five years.
- 8 (b) Results.--Test results under subsection (a) shall be
- 9 transmitted to the governmental entity that is in control of the
- 10 building. Test results under subsection (a) are public records.
- 11 Test results under subsection (a) shall be maintained by the
- 12 department for five years and shall be available for public
- 13 inspection.
- 14 Section 4. Regulations.
- 15 The department shall promulgate regulations to administer
- 16 this act.
- 17 Section 5. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$3,000,000, or as much thereof as may be
- 19 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of
- 20 Environmental Resources for the fiscal year July 1, 1988, to
- 21 June 30, 1989, to carry out the provisions of this act.
- 22 Section 6. Effective date.
- 23 This act shall take effect as follows:
- 24 (1) Section 4 and this section shall take effect
- 25 immediately.
- 26 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect in 90
- days.
