A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of February 8 through 14, 1987, as "Scout 2 Anniversary Week."
- 3 WHEREAS, The concept of scouting was created by Lord Baden-
- 4 Powell over 77 years ago; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The world scouting movement has made significant
- 6 contributions to the world, the Nation and this Commonwealth;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, There are over 200,000 young men and 60,000 adults
- 9 involved with Boy Scouting in this Commonwealth; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The first man to walk on the moon, astronaut Neil
- 11 Armstrong, was an Eagle Scout; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Many of our past leaders, including presidents,
- 13 congressmen, judges and clergy were members of the scouting
- 14 movement; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Scouting has emphasized leadership in the
- 16 communities, schools and families for the past 77 years; and
- 17 WHEREAS, "Scout Anniversary Week" is being celebrated from

- February 8 through 14, 1987; therefore be it 1
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 3 week of February 8 through 14, 1987, as "Scout Anniversary Week"
- 4 and urges its celebration throughout the Commonwealth.
