## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the House Committee on Federal-State Relations to
- 2 investigate the possibility of placing a veterans' home at
- 3 the South Mountain Restoration Center.
- 4 WHEREAS, The South Mountain Restoration Center, a beautiful
- 5 facility located in southern Franklin County, has existed under
- 6 the Department of Public Welfare for several years; and
- 7 WHEREAS, There are several vacant buildings in the Center at
- 8 present time, and the number of clients has declined over the
- 9 past several years; and
- 10 WHEREAS, It may be desirable to locate a new veterans' home
- 11 utilizing the vacant buildings at the Center; therefore be it
- 12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the House
- 13 Committee on Federal-State Relations to investigate the
- 14 possibility of placing a veterans' home at the South Mountain
- 15 Restoration Center; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 17 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 18 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee

- shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 2 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the committee shall report to the House of 3
- 4 Representatives on its activities, findings and recommendations
- 5 in 90 days.
