A RESOLUTION

- 1 Directing the Transportation Committee to investigate the
- 2 feasibility of the Bureau of Aviation establishing a travel
- 3 agency to arrange for travel by Commonwealth employees.
- 4 WHEREAS, Millions of State dollars are expended each year for
- 5 travel expenses and accommodations for Commonwealth employees;
- 6 and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth would effect a substantial savings
- 8 on travel expenses and accommodations for its employees if an
- 9 agency of the Commonwealth were to become a travel agency;
- 10 therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
- 12 Transportation Committee to investigate the feasibility of the
- 13 Bureau of Aviation within the Department of Transportation
- 14 establishing a travel agency to arrange for travel by
- 15 Commonwealth employees; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
- 17 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
- 18 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee

- shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
- 2 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of the findings 3
- 4 and recommendations to the House of Representatives as soon as
- 5 possible.
