A RESOLUTION

1 Directing the Transportation Committee to investigate the
2 feasibility of the Bureau of Aviation establishing a travel
3 agency to arrange for travel by Commonwealth employees.

4 WHEREAS, Millions of State dollars are expended each year for
5 travel expenses and accommodations for Commonwealth employees;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth would effect a substantial savings
8 on travel expenses and accommodations for its employees if an
9 agency of the Commonwealth were to become a travel agency;
10 therefore be it

11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
12 Transportation Committee to investigate the feasibility of the
13 Bureau of Aviation within the Department of Transportation
14 establishing a travel agency to arrange for travel by
15 Commonwealth employees; and be it further

16 RESOLVED, That the committee may hold hearings, take
17 testimony and make its investigations at such places as it deems
18 necessary in this Commonwealth. Each member of the committee

1 shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations to
2 witnesses appearing before the committee; and be it further
3 RESOLVED, That the committee make a report of the findings
4 and recommendations to the House of Representatives as soon as
5 possible.
