A RESOLUTION

1 Memorializing Congress to establish a cabinet-level Department  
2 of Veterans' Affairs.

3 WHEREAS, The need for proper and efficient programs and  
4 services for veterans of our Armed Forces requires an  
5 appropriate cabinet-level organization; and

6 WHEREAS, The President of the United States has suggested to  
7 Congress that it enact legislation creating a Department of  
8 Veterans' Affairs; therefore be it

9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the  
10 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania memorialize the Congress of the  
11 United States to enact legislation establishing a cabinet-level  
12 Department of Veterans' Affairs; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to  
14 the presiding officers of each house of Congress and to each  
15 member of Congress from Pennsylvania.
