A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the week of February 8, 1988, as Cholesterol
- 2 Awareness Week of American Heart Month in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Heart disease is the Nation's leading cause of

1 death; and

2 WHEREAS, High blood cholesterol is associated with an
3 increased risk of heart disease, specifically heart attack; and

4 WHEREAS, Cholesterol can only be detected by specific
5 testing; and

6 WHEREAS, Pennsylvanians may help prevent heart attacks and
7 strokes by controlling their cholesterol levels through proper
8 diet, and, when appropriate, diet in combination with
9 cholesterol lowering medications; therefore be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
11 week of February 8, 1988, as Cholesterol Awareness Week of
12 American Heart Month in Pennsylvania to encourage cholesterol
13 awareness programs in local communities throughout this
14 Commonwealth.
