A RESOLUTION

1 Requesting the Governor to direct the Pennsylvania Liquor
2 Control Board to review and reconsider certain actions
3 relating to the reduction or elimination of certain
4 discounts.

5 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, on November
6 14, 1988, issued a series of rulings which reduced retail
7 licensee purchase discounts from 12 1/2% to 7% and eliminated
8 certain retail bulk purchase discounts; and

9 WHEREAS, The affected discounts had been longstanding Liquor
10 Board policy on which retailers and purchasers formulated
11 budgetary plans and relied upon to enter into various
12 contractual arrangements; and

13 WHEREAS, The action of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board
14 has had and will continue to have an adverse effect on retail
15 licensees and consumers; therefore be it

16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives respectfully
17 request the Governor to issue administrative directives to the
18 Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board directing that board to
19 reconsider and further review its rulings on discounts and,

1 during such review, to retain the discounts to the levels in
2 effect prior to November 14, 1988; and be it further
3 RESOLVED, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to
4 the Governor.
