A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, prohibiting members of the General Assembly
- from receiving any increase in an unvouchered expense
- 4 allowance during a current term of office.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby resolves as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 8 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 9 That section 8 of Article II be amended to read:
- 10 § 8. Compensation.
- 11 The members of the General Assembly shall receive such salary
- 12 and mileage for regular and special sessions as shall be fixed
- 13 by law, and no other compensation whatever, whether for service
- 14 upon committee or otherwise. No member of either House shall
- 15 during the term for which he may have been elected, receive any
- 16 increase of salary, unvouchered expense allowance, or mileage,
- 17 under any law passed during such term.
