AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10	Amending the act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112), entitled "An act relating to the right to practice medicine and surgery and the right to practice medically related acts; reestablishing the State Board of Medical Education and Licensure as the State Board of Medicine and providing for its composition, powers and duties; providing for the issuance of licenses and certificates and the suspension and revocation of licenses and certificates; providing penalties; and making repeals," further providing for the writing of drug prescriptions by physicians.

12	hereby enacts as follows:
13	Section 1. The act of December 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112),
14	known as the Medical Practice Act of 1985, is amended by adding
15	a section to read:
16	Section 37.1. Writing of prescriptions.
17	All prescriptions for drugs written by physicians shall
18	contain the full name of the prescription drug and clear dosage
19	instructions. The drug name and the dosage instructions shall
20	not be abbreviated.
21	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
